

ATTRACTION RATING: HIGH THRILL

RULES

WARNING: Only you know your limitations. Please make a responsible decision when determining your ability to participate. This is a very strenuous ride. The moving water is extremely turbulent. Please see a Team Member for additional information if necessary. Guests may not ride if unable to understand and follow safety procedures. Guests must demonstrate appropriate observed behavior indicating a willingness and ability to participate and/or follow rider requirements. Failure to follow verbal instructions and posted guidelines may result in serious injury or expulsion from the park.

- 1. You must be 42" tall to ride.
- 2. Observe "How to Ride" instructions before enjoying this attraction.
- 3. Enter and exit from the sides only. Avoid jumping into or entering the ride at high speed; avoid weight on front foot. Single riding only is permitted.
- 4. Bathing suit tops, bottoms and loose clothing may be pulled off by the flowing water. Cover-ups are recommended.
- 5. The following are not allowed in the attraction:
 - * Tubes.
 - * Swim wear with buckles, rivets, zippers or any sharp object; jeans or cut-offs.
 - * Smoking, eating, or drinking.
 - * Running, diving, horseplay, or breath holding.
- * Footwear.
- * Loose articles such as shoes, jewelry, sunglasses, cameras, or phones.
- * Personal items should be secured in a locker or left in the care of others while enjoying water attractions. Magic Springs is not responsible for the care, loss, or damage of these items.
- * Lounge or beach chairs.

- * Standing or flipping on the boards.

 * Guests wearing neck braces and/or casts of any kind.

 * Tandem or multi-person riding.

 * Walking on the ride surface. The surface of this ride is very slippery.

 6. Riders may not exceed a maximum 250 pounds.
- 7. Riders must wait for lifeguard to signal before starting ride.
- 8. It is recommended that you do not participate if you; have a heart condition, nervous disorder, motion sickness, weak back or neck, leg or arm cast, or are obese, physically impaired, or an infant. You should
- not ride if you have a significant physical ailment or condition.

 9. Anyone who has experienced stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two weeks may not participate in any water attraction.
- 10. Lifeguards may clear the pool at certain times.
- 11. Please obey ALL lifeguard instructions.













If you are hearing impaired, ask the ride attendant for written ride instructions before boarding the ride.
