



Attraction Rating: : Moderate Thrill

You must be 36" tall to ride slides. Some slides require 40" minimum. Maximum weight per single rider may NOT exceed 200 pounds. Some slides allow up to 250 pounds.

- Rider will encounter strong accelerations and decelerations forces from the front, rear, and all side during the course for the ride.
- The following are NOT allowed on this ride:
 - People chains. Only one person is to enter the slide at a time.
 - Standing, kneeling, rotating, or stopping in or on the slide.
 - Headfirst sliding on slides or in tunnels.
 - Climbing on pipes or handrails.
 - Hanging or swinging on pull ropes.
 - Swimwear with buckles, rivets, zippers or any sharp object; jeans or cut offs.
 - Lifejackets.
 - Smoking, eating, or drinking.
 - Running, diving, horseplay, or breathholding.
 - Footwear.
 - Loose articles such as shoes, jewelry, sunglasses, cameras, or phones.
- Personal items should be secured in a locker or left in the care of others while enjoying water attractions. Magic Springs is NOT responsible for the care, loss, or damage of these items.
- Only Park-issued or U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices are allowed on the tube slides.
- Be aware of the water depth at all times.
- Riders must wait for lifeguard to signal before starting ride.
- Keep arms, hands, and feet inside the slide at all times.
- Slide must be ridden feet first lying on your back or in a sitting position. Sit up to go slower or lay down to go faster.
- It is recommended that you do not participate if you: have a heart condition, nervous disorder, motion sickness, weak back or neck, leg or arm cast, or are obese, physically impaired, pregnant, or an infant. You should not ride if you have a significant physical ailment or condition.
- Anyone who has experienced stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two weeks may not participate in any water attraction.
- At the end of the slide please exit the runout as quickly as possible.
- Please see riding instructions before you enter the slide.
- Lifeguards may clear the tower at certain times.
- Please obey ALL lifeguard instructions.
